At the end of this year students will be tested on Module D (Literature), Module E and an oral exam.

**Module D:**

Instead of the external literature Bagrut exam, teachers will write and mark their own internal exam.

**LOTS, HOTS and Bridging Text and Context questions.**

**Texts for the internal Bagrut exam:**

Mr. Know All (a short story)

Thank You Ma'am / Langston Hughes (a short story)

A Summer's Reading / Bernard Malamud (a short story)

The Road Not Taken / Robert Frost (a poem)

Count That Day Lost / George Eliot (a poem)

Grandmother / Sameeneh Shirazie (a poem)

The following are the higher-order thinking skills that are required to be taught to students answering the extended HOTS question:

- **Comparing and contrasting**
- **Distinguishing different perspectives**
- **Explaining cause and effect**
- **Explaining patterns**
- **Inferring**
- **Uncovering motives**

### **Module E:**

- 1 Unseen (70p.)
- Access to Information from Spoken Text (30p.)

### **The Oral Exam:**

Students will be tested by external teachers from other schools who are appointed by the Testing Department. The oral exam includes 2 parts: 1) an interview (40%) 2) project (60%). Students will be asked to present their project and to answer questions about it. The student **MUST** bring his project for the exam otherwise he/she will not be tested on it. The maximum grade for the oral exam without the project is 40.

### **Tests:**

- Students must bring their own dictionaries to tests and quizzes.
- Students will not attend a make-up test without the English teacher's *or* the English coordinator's authorization.
