**Module C:**

Access to Information from written Text (70 p.)

Written Presentation (70-90 words) (30p.)

Students will be taught and tested on the following writing formats:

A personal letter

A description

**Project**

A project will be done in class with the guidance of the teacher.

**The Oral Exam:**

Students will be tested by their own teachers. The oral exam includes 2 parts:1) an interview (40%) 2) project (60%). Students will be asked to present their project and to answer questions about it. The student **MUST** bring his project for the exam otherwise he/she will not be tested on it. The maximum grade for the oral exam without the project is 40

**Tests:**

- Students must bring their own dictionaries to tests and quizzes.
- Students will not attend a make-up test without the English teacher's *or* the English coordinator's authorization.
